

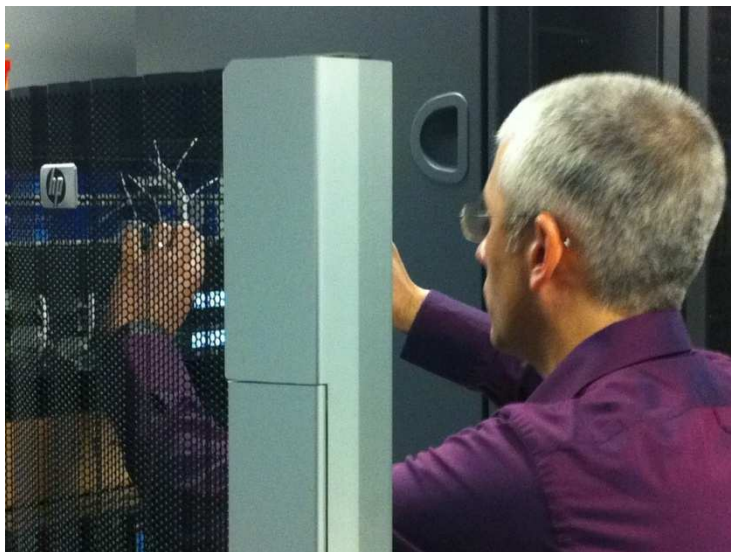


Physical Transfer of the EU LRIT DC primary configuration - from CLS to EMSA *March 2011*

- as per agreed transfer plan -



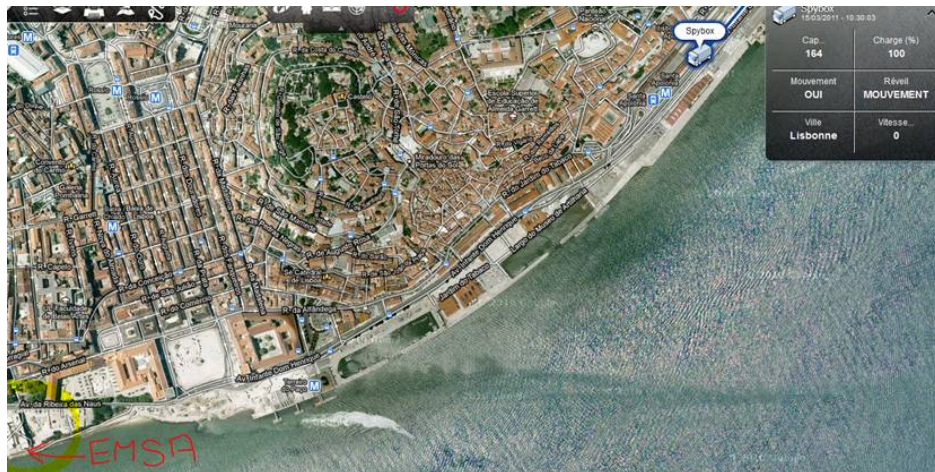
Th. 10th March 2011: in preparation of the physical transfer: switch from the EU LRIT DC primary configuration to a temporary configuration hosted by CLS (Disaster Recovery configuration still up and running, operated by CLS)



Mo. 14th March 2011: EU LRIT DC (primary configuration) ready to depart from CLS (Toulouse, France)



Mo. 14th to Tu. 15th March 2011: The EU LRIT DC (primary configuration) on its way to EMSA



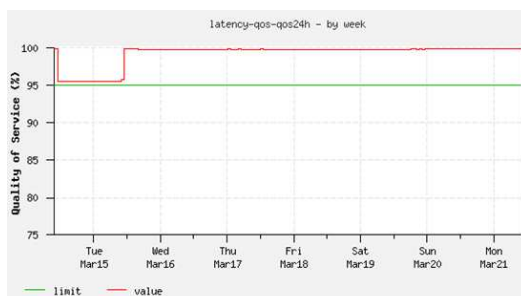
Tu. 15th March 2011: Arrival of the EU LRIT DC (primary configuration) at EMSA

(primary configuration) into the EMSA network




Th. 17th March 2011: Switch back on the primary configuration now operating from EMSA HQ. No impact on the QoS.
